BT has confirmed that we do have the necessary electricity connection to the telephone box, so the defibrillator can be connected.

More good news: BT has offered to fund the cost of the electricity for the next seven years!

LIVES, a group of highly trained 'First Responders', are volunteers who do not receive a salary, but offer an outstanding contribution to the overstretched NHS and other emergency responders. One of their team has provided training in life-saving techniques and using a defibrillator to 12 local residents. This was the first wave of volunteers on our list, but LIVES will be returning to provide training for the remaining 42 people.
