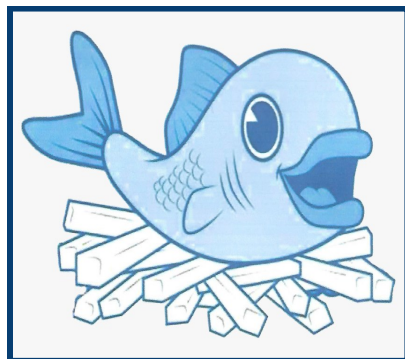

What is Pilates?

- ⇒ Non-Impact Exercises that improve Strength, Flexibility, Posture, Balance & Coordination as well as relieving stress and tension - it is an exercise for the Mind & Body.
- ⇒ Suitable for ALL ages and abilities.
- ⇒ Pilates was developed by German born Joseph Pilates, who realised that mental and physical health are closely linked. His method has been influenced by a range of exercises including yoga, gymnastics and martial arts.

What do I need?

- ⇒ Please wear loose comfortable clothing, non-slip socks and bring along an exercise mat. Other equipment can be purchased from Max.

Who is Max?!

- ⇒ Max has been a Chartered Physiotherapist since 1998 and is a Senior Musculoskeletal Physiotherapist at Fitzwilliam Hospital in Peterborough. She is a Certified Matwork Class Instructor with the Australian Physiotherapy and Pilates Institute based in London having started her training in 2001. She has been teaching Pilates in Bourne since 2011. Max ensures that class participants receive clear instructions so that they can work at their own level and provides different classes every week. She uses a variety of small equipment to ensure that the body and mind are challenged but in a fun, safe and effective way.

- ⇒ Cost is £9.00 per class. Classes are held mainly during school term-times. These are booked as a block in advance. If you are unable to attend, there will be a £5 refund.

DYKE GARDENERS

If you are new to gardening, or you'd just like a timely reminder, here are a few things you might like to try this month:

Lift and store dahlia and begonia tubers

Plant tulip bulbs

Plant onion, garlic and shallots—start them off in large cells if the ground isn't ready

Prune apple and pear trees but not plum and other stoned fruit trees

Sow hardy broad beans (e.g. Aquadulce) and winter salad leaves

Plant out winter bedding such as pansies, wallflowers, forget-me-nots, Bellis daisies, Primula and Viola
