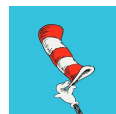

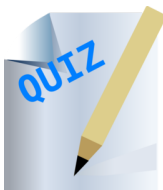

## **Plant and Gardenalia Sale**

**Sunday 15th May 2-4pm**

Getting ready to spruce up your garden for summer? Planning to plant up your garden with red, white and blue flowers for the Jubilee? Growing your own to save a few pennies?

Pop down to the Village Hall and see what floral splendours, vegetable wonders and general garden delights we have on offer.

Tomato plants, sunflower seedlings, basket plants, pots, ornaments and tools.

If, like me, you have been over-enthusiastic with your seed planting and once again have a surplus of plants or too many pots or garden tools you don't use, please consider donating them for this event and then come along and get some more!!

## ***DYKE GARDENERS May/June***

- Cut back spring-flowering shrubs such as Japanese quince, choisya and ribes after flowering
- Once frosts have passed, prune tender penstemon, caryopteris and fuchsia
- Top dress containers by scrapping away the top layers and adding fresh compost and slow release food pellets
- Prune unruly Clematis montana after blooming if necessary and tie in summer flowering climbers
- Direct sow hardy annuals such as nasturtiums, poppies, nigella and cosmos
- Trim back aubretia after flowering has finished
- Pick sweet peas to prolong the growing season
- If there is no frost forecast plant out summer bedding and position containers and hanging baskets
- Earth up potatoes and ensure they are well watered
- Keep on top of weeds and pests in the vegetable patch and lawn



**OPEN GARDENS** - Please consider opening your garden for our Jubilee village walking trail which will take place on the afternoon of Saturday 4th June. We will start at Eastgate House and visit gardens in the village before ending up at an undisclosed location for a wee drinkie and nibbles. This is being kept low key

for village inhabitants and their friends and family rather than promoting it more widely. It really doesn't matter if your lawn is not perfectly manicured or you have weeds in your borders it's just a fun activity to allow us to get to know our neighbours and talk about plants!!
